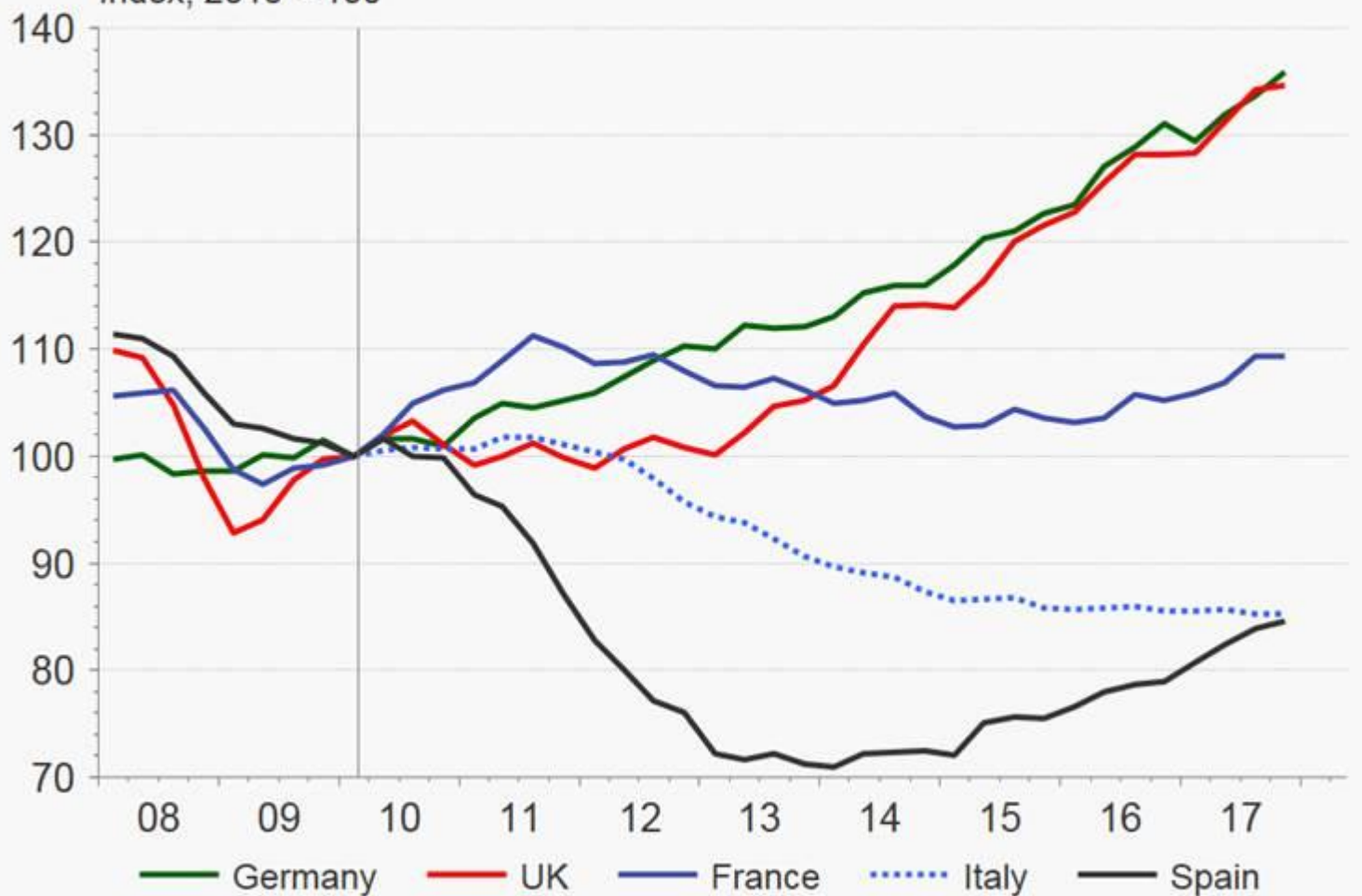
Real estate in Europe. Where is being invested the most?

The European real estate market seems to have blossomed and attracted investors again. With artificially low interest rates due to the European Central Bank's monetary policy, buying stocks has deemed too risky while bonds have simply turned (deliberately) unattractive.

Within this environment, investors look into property for safety and yield. Despite that, approximately 32 percent of respondents in recent polls indicate they are concerned about European economic growth impacting direct investments in real estate.
