What is this product?

Type

The Fund has been created as a "Société d'Investissement à Capital Variable" governed by the Luxembourg law of 13 February 2007 relating to specialised investment funds, as amended.

The Fund qualified as an alternative investment fund in accordance with the provisions of the Luxembourg law of 12 July 2013 on alternative investment fund managers, as amended.

The Fund is an open-end fund.

Objectives

The Sub-Fund aims at capital appreciation and while controlling the risks related to the assets classes (preservation) by investing mainly in a selected portfolio of international equity

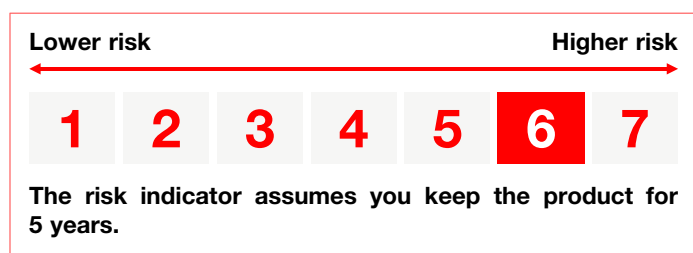
and equity-linked instruments (including but not limited to ordinary or preferred shares, convertibles bonds), bonds and debt securities and instruments of all types (including but not limited to fixed rate or floating securities, zero-coupon bonds and treasury bonds). The Sub-Fund may achieve its investment objective indirectly, by investing through other UCIs/UCITS, including ETFs.

Intended retail investor

This Sub-Fund may be suitable for investors looking for a higher risk income strategy to complement an existing core portfolio, or looking to potentially enhance medium term returns and who are comfortable with the extra risks inherent in the Sub-Fund. The Fund is exclusively targeted at well-informed investors who can be deemed to be advised investors.

What are the risks and what could I get in return?

Risks



The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets or because we are not able to pay you.

We have classified this product as 6 out of 7, which is the second-highest risk class.

This rates the potential losses from future performance at a high level, and poor market conditions are very likely to impact our capacity to pay you.

Be aware of currency risk. You will receive payments in a different currency, so the final return you will get depend on the exchange rate between the two currencies. This risk is not considered in the indicator shown above.

The Sub-Fund is subject to credit risk, equity risk, default risk, use of derivatives and liquidity risk.
