

Objectives and investment policy

- The objective is to achieve a combination of income and long-term capital appreciation, targeting a yearly average return of 1.5% in excess of the Euro Interbank Offered Rate (Euribor 3 months) commensurate with a moderate level of risk.
- The Sub-Fund will invest primarily in units of UCITS and UCIs, and eligible Exchange Traded Funds ("ETFs")
- The investment manager intents to invest in emerging markets, through the underlying UCITS, UCIs or ETFs, up to 40% of the portfolio.
- The Sub-Fund may invest, to a limited extent, directly in equity securities and debt securities. Cash and cash equivalents may also be held on an ancillary basis.
- The Sub-Fund may invest up to 100% of its net assets in cash and cash equivalents, term deposits, debt securities and money market instruments dealt in on a Regulated Market and whose maturity does not exceed 12 months, monetary UCITS and UCIs.

- The sub-fund may also use all types of financial derivative instruments for hedging and efficient portfolio management (maximum exposure: 100%).
- Recommendation: this sub-fund may not be appropriate for investors who plan to withdraw their money within 3 years.
- Unitholders may redeem units on demand, on a daily basis.
- Non-distributing units: any income generated by the sub-fund is reinvested.
- Please note that transaction costs may have material impact on performance.

Risk and reward profile

- The lowest class does not mean that the investment is risk free.

Consequently, both the expected return and the potential risk of loss may be average.

The sub-fund is subject to the following risks:

- Use of derivatives: derivatives may be used for hedging and other purposes.
- Duplication of certain fees and expenses when investments are made in other funds.
- Emerging markets: may be subject to less developed custody and settlement practices, higher volatility and lower liquidity than nonemerging markets.

Charges

The charges you pay are used to pay the costs of running the sub-fund, including the costs of marketing and distributing it. These charges reduce the potential growth of your investment.


One-off charges taken before or after you invest	
Entry charge	up to 2.00%

The **entry charge** shown is a maximum figure. In some cases you might pay less; you can find this out from your sales agent or financial advisor.

The **ongoing charges** figure shown is based on the expenses paid for the year ending 31 December 2017. This figure may vary from year to year. It excludes portfolio transaction costs, except in the case of an entry/exit charge paid by the fund when buying or selling units in another collective investment undertaking.
